



What can a health and safety representative do?



Represent

the work group in matters relating to health and safety in the workplace



Participate

in the health and safety committee



Monitor

the PCBU's compliance with the Work Health and Safety Act 2020



Inspect

the workplace areas they represent after giving the PCBU reasonable notice



Inquire

into work health and safety risks to workers in the work group



After completion of the relevant training an HSR can:



Investigate

work health and safety complaints from members of the work group



Issue

a provisional improvement notice (PIN) when they reasonably believe that there is a contravention of the WHS Act, after consultation



Accompany

a WorkSafe inspector during an inspection of the workplace



Direct

a work group member to cease unsafe work when there is reasonable concern that carrying out the work would expose workers of the work group to a serious risk
